- d. Phase 4 Construction :: Bryant Ave to Annapolis St
 - i. Utility work is being performed concurrently with Phase 3 work
 - ii. Roadway construction work along east side to begin in July 2022
 - iii. Anticipated substantial completion November 2022
 - iv. Upcoming Utility Work
 - Storm Sewer Under UPRR Tracks
 - Tunneling pit located at the northeast corner of Hotel Furniture Liquidators property
 - Anticipated to begin the week of June 27th through July 30th
 - Sanitary / Storm Sewer – North of Simon’s Ravine on East Side
 - Sanitary Sewer – Adjacent to 1009 Concord St
4. Construction Detours / Traffic Impacts
 - a. Regional Traffic Detour
 - b. Road / Lane Closures
 - Southbound Concord St :: Wentworth Ave to Bryant Ave
 - **Closed to traffic into July 2022**
 - **Local traffic detoured via map**
 - Access properties between Wentworth Ave and Bryant Ave from south
 - Southbound Concord St :: Butler Ave to Bryant Ave
 - **Closed to through traffic June 27th – June 29th**
 - **Closed to all traffic between Bryant Ave and 1009 Concord St**
 - **Through traffic detoured via map at Butler Ave**
 - Two-way business access maintained between Butler Ave and 1009 Concord St
 - Northbound Concord St :: Butler Ave to Annapolis St
 - **Closed to traffic on weekdays, June 20th – July 1st**
 - **Local traffic detoured via map**
 - Open to weekend traffic for Kaposia Days
 - **See weekly construction updates for any changes in short term lane and access closures**
